

# BELL FAMILY REPRODUCTION FOR 2009



The Nicodemus Center will be offering the tenth piece in its annual series of Bell family reproductions this fall. The series features one reproduction per year in a limited edition of 150. This year's reproduction is being created by the center's executive director and ceramist James Smith. Orders may be placed by using the order form below or by e-mailing the center at [jms48@psu.edu](mailto:jms48@psu.edu). The cost is \$65 per piece plus \$3.90 sales tax for center members and \$70 plus \$4.20 sales tax for nonmembers. After October 1, orders for the reproductions will also be available to the general public at a cost of \$75 plus \$4.50 sales tax.

For 2009, the reproduction is a salt-glazed stoneware lidded canning jar with cobalt blue tulip decorations on the shoulder. It measures 5.75 inches in height and 3.75 inches in diameter at the base. The original stoneware jar is stamped JOHN BELL/WAYNESBORO on the shoulder and was made in John Bell's Waynesboro shop between the mid 1850s and 1880.

The lidded canning jar is the first salt-glaze stoneware piece to be offered in the annual reproduction series by the center. The 150 jars and lids will be fired this fall in a wood-fired salt kiln at Allison Severance's Coles Pottery near Boonsboro, MD.
